



Camp Wilani Behavior Agreement

I, _____, as a camper at Camp Wilani agree to:

- Follow the safety rules and policies of camp. (See back for behavior policies)
- Cooperate with other campers and staff.
- Respect the rights and properties of others. If I feel threatened I will immediately tell my counselor or another staff member.
- Listen and follow instruction.
- Think about the consequences of my actions.
- Participate in activities.
- Be a responsible member of the camp community.
- Respect the natural environment.
- I understand that electronic equipment is not permitted at camp. If I bring it to camp it will be taken away and returned to my parents upon departure.
- Commit to honesty.
- Commit to try.

I realize that if my behavior does not contribute to a safe, pleasant and harmonious camp environment, I may be sent home. If I am sent home, there will be no refund of my camp fee. My parent/guardian or person designated on the Camp Registration form is responsible for my immediate transportation from camp.

Camp Wilani Behavior Policies:

Camp Wilani is a tobacco free and drug free facility.

No staff member, camp visitor or camper is permitted to smoke at any time in any camp facility or while on camp property. The property begins at Bolton Hill Road. Smoking in private vehicles on camp property is not permitted.

DRUGS, ALCOHOL, CIGARETTES & WEAPONS

A camper found to be using or in possession of alcohol, drugs, drug paraphernalia, cigarettes, lighters, matches, knives or any type of weapon **or** remaining at any site where such items are knowingly being used, will be immediately sent home from camp at the expense of his/her parent or guardian.

Note: Pocket knives, when appropriate, are supplied by the camp to be used on campouts, field activities or for craft projects, after training and always under supervision. Personal knives must be left at home.

BULLYING, FIGHTING, ASSAULTS OR ENDANGERING OTHERS

Camp Wilani has zero tolerance for bullying, fighting, assaults or actions that endanger campers or staff.

Bullying means one or more people excluding, teasing, taunting, gossiping, hitting, kicking, or putting down another person with the intent to hurt him/her physically or emotionally.

Assault means a verbal or physical attack on another person(s) who does not wish to engage in the conflict and who has not provoked the assault.

Fighting means aggressive, hostile bodily contact with other campers.

CHRONICALLY DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR

Campers may be sent home for chronically disruptive behavior. Such behavior is defined as verbal or physical activity that may include, but is not limited to, behavior that:

- Requires constant attention from the staff.
- Inflicts physical or emotional harm on children or staff.
- Displays destructive behavior.

LEAVING CAMP PROPERTY

A camper who leaves or attempts to leave camp property or a camp program or activity away from the campsite without the permission of a staff member will be sent home immediately.

IMPROPER SEXUAL BEHAVIOR

Intentionally approaching or touching another camper or staff member in a sexual manner is grounds for dismissal from camp, as is any behavior that violates the personal space of another camper or staff member. This includes sexual advances, requests for sexual acts or favors, sexually explicit language or physical conduct of a sexual nature.
